Dear friends in Christ,

May is traditionally a month set aside to honor Mary, the Mother of God and Mother of the Church. Continuing our parish tradition, there will be a **May Crowning Mass** with our school children at 8:00 am this Wednesday, May 5. All are invited to join us. In addition, a second May Crowning will be held that evening as part of the *One Church, One Faith* gathering.

This Wednesday, we conclude our ***One Church, One Faith: Week One*** gatherings with a May Crowning Mass and celebration dinner. Join us beginning at 6:00 pm on May 5 for a Mass in honor of our Blessed Mother, including a crowning of the statue of Mary in front of the church bell tower. Following Mass, we will gather in Wagner Hall for a pitch-in dinner to celebrate the success of the first year of *One Church, One Faith*. The parish will provide sandwiches, drinks, plates, and silverware. We invite all families attending to bring a dish to share according to the first letter of their last name:

A-G – bring a dessert

H-O – bring a salad

P-Z – bring a vegetable

We will also have available at the Week One gathering a list of all summer parish activities, from the annual Parish Picnic to Summer Daze for middle school students to a ten-week intensive Adult Faith Formation class led by Fr. Eric. Complete information on summer activities will also be published in an upcoming bulletin.

This coming Saturday, the **Liturgical Ministers Day of Reflection** that was cancelled earlier in the year because of snow will be held. This important day of prayer, reflection, and training is for all Greeters, Ushers, Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Music Ministers, and Mass Coordinators. If you have not yet responded to the invitation that was sent through the Ministry Scheduler program to your e-mail or home address, please call the parish office this week so we know how many people to plan for. The day begins at 7:45 am and concludes at 12:15 pm with lunch.

Finally, this week there will be a meeting of a newly-established **Parish Fundraising Committee**. As groups within the parish have held fundraising activities in recent years, we have seen a need to coordinate these activities and spread them out throughout the year so that parishioners and family members are not bombarded with several fundraising events all at the same time. Moving forward, **all fundraising events held by any group associated with the parish or school must be approved by the Parish Fundraising Committee**. A Fundraiser Request Form must be filled out and submitted to the parish or school office at least 3 months prior to the requested date. The committee will meet to review all requests and then will inform the requesting group or individual of their decision. The Fundraising Request Form can be found on the parish and school websites, or you may call the parish or school office to receive a copy. The form includes contact information for committee members if you have any questions. We hope that this committee will be able to coordinate all fundraising activities in the parish so that they best benefit the organizations sponsoring them.
